We were tasked with creating the FOSM Christmas cards, so we chose to use our hands or feet to create Christmas trees- there were lots of squeals of delight when having green feet!!










Some children got to experience Yoga for the first time! Poses have included 'things that live in water' and our own version of Old McDonald using a variety of animal poses.



We have taken part in **Now press play**- All children (and adults) wear headphones and are transported through stories (Ours were Weather and The Gingerbread Man) immersing themselves, following the instructions and sounds and being imaginative.



We have enjoyed picking and tasting plums from our own tree, observing changes and using lots of mathematical language and teamwork. The children also took part in a smelling and tasting activity, as we talked about our five senses.

We have learned some Harvest songs in our weekly singing assembly and collected leaves and other natural resources to create Autumn crowns and pictures. The children have enjoyed exploring, investigating and experimenting with rain water, gloop, playdough and water colour paints- collecting and adding their own resources to extend and develop their own play ideas
