Dear Parents/Carers

Last term was quite busy and short few weeks but the children crammed in lots of activities

We looked at the cold weather, investigated ice and talked about changes in the environment. The children tested their thoughts and ideas, making ice baubles – using coloured water, natural resources and sparkles and then leaving their creations out over night to see if the water would freeze.

We talked about birds in the colder weather and how they may struggle to get food with the ground being so hard. We carefully threaded cereals on to pipe cleaners and proudly placed them on the trees. We also shared bird stories which inspired us to look at different forces- push and pull- which lead beautifully to magnets and lots of play and investigation with them.



Next, we looked at Spiders and Bees-

Creating models, linking our number and sound of the week-8 and s, making chalk webs. We used potato mashers and other kitchen utensils to create bee pictures, we watched slow motion clips of spiders spinning their webs and bees collecting pollen. The children explored patterns using the peg boards and used tweezers to collect and add pom pom pollen from numbered flowers.





The children also loved being measured by the Year 6 children!





We then moved on to Snails...... We shared fiction and non-fiction books to find out more about them.

We then looked at the artist Henri Matisse and some of his well-known paintings including The Snail. The children enjoyed cutting and sticking coloured paper, like Matisse, to create their own version of the famous picture. We also experimented with Numicon, to create snails- finding different ways to make 5.



We celebrated Storytelling week- shared a different story each day, from each class in school

We have enjoyed Rhyming bingo, finding rhyming pairs and strings

We looked at the celebration of Chinese New Year. The children watched The Great Race story- told by shadow puppets, explaining why each year is named after a different animal and how the order was chosen. We loved looking at what animal we were!!

The children created blossom trees, red Chinese lanterns and enjoyed some watercolour painting.

We created dragon pictures using our handprints too.











As we begin the new term could we please ask if you could help your child by not bringing toys from home.

From this term if children do bring things in they will be put back in to their bags. This is also to prepare them for the transition to school.
